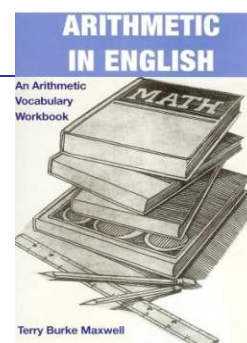

Arithmetic In English explains commonly used arithmetic terms with everyday words. It combines skill practice with reading to help readers understand the language of arithmetic. This 8-1/2" x 11" spiral-bound workbook supports the learner's classroom experience or the learner's previous math education. The workbook assumes the learner is using a textbook that's appropriate for age or grade, or already has mastered arithmetic topics in a language other than English.

- **Covers a Wide Range of Learners**

Reading practice and exercises relieve the confusion some learners experience when they see or hear mathematical terms. Used with a tutor, friend or classmate, parent or grandparent, or even out loud alone, the workbook lets the learner see, hear, and say standard math terms. Suitable for middle school, community college, tutors, adult education, and teacher education, *Arithmetic In English* presents math vocabulary terms the way they'd be explained in an arithmetic class.

- **Written for Different Language and Skill Levels**

English learners will find this workbook invaluable as they study the English terms for familiar math topics. Teachers might assign partners or small groups to practice arithmetic vocabulary that relates to classroom presentations or remedial goals. Tutors can easily assess a learner's mastery or needs with the arithmetic terms and topics. Vocabulary explanations and examples help grandparents and other adults recall their own use and study of arithmetic.

- **Appears In Easy to Use Format**

Each topic first lists commonly used terms. Then written material encourages students to read the terms out loud. When appropriate, practice exercises combine hands-on computation skills with reading mathematics language and symbols. A pronunciation guide shows accent marks to assist with proper emphasis when saying the word. The index provides quick reference, in both English and Spanish. Professional O-ring binding means the workbook lies flat for easy use.

- **Answers Support Proper Reading of the Math Terms**

Math textbooks often supply answers at the back of the workbook, and it's tempting to peek at these before doing all the work. However, in *Arithmetic In English* the goal is not to focus on the numerical answer. Rather, it is to practice the proper terminology describing the problem and the answer, by reading numbers and symbols out loud. Thus the answers in the workbook are wordy and detailed, giving more than a numerical answer.
